

REDUCTION OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (RoHS)

WizLAN's Self-declaration

WizLAN will meet all requirements of the European Union's Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive. RoHS restricts the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium and two bromine-containing flame-retardants: PBB (polybrominated biphenyls) and PBDE (polybrominated diphenyl ethers) in electrical and electronic products placed on the European Market on and after July 1, 2006. Exemptions allow the continued use of lead in networking infrastructure equipment and a few select components.

WizLAN is working closely with its supply chain to assure compliance of all product and materials supplied by partners.

WizLAN's initiative to comply with the RoHS Directive is part of its engineering quality policy and commitment, which includes design for environment, reduction in the use of hazardous materials, product take-back and recycling and supplier responsibility.
